H. Fairytrail Bride	A cascading lace cap hydrangea that looks stunning when grown in a container. White flowers are born in summer.	4'h x 4'w	part shade	Blooms on old wood
H. Arborescens Annabelle	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Annabelle, earns it reputation as one of the best-loved, smooth leaf hydrangeas. Large crisp white blooms.	3-5' tall	part shade	prune hard to about 12"
H. Arborescens Haas Halo	Smooth leaf hydrangea, a remarkable lace cap that produces large white blooms that are more than 14" wide. Held upright on sturdy stems.	3-5' tall	part shade	prune hard to about 12"
H. Arborescens Incrediball	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Extra large blooms open lime-green mature to brilliant white, then back to pale green in late summer. Very sturdy stems. Flowers are great dried.	4-5' tall	morning sun	prune hard to about 12"
H. Arborescens Incrediball Blush	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Extra large flowers are a unique silvery-pink that ages to a green color that can be snipped off to encourage rebloom or left to age on the plant.	4-5' tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Lace	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Plum-perfect lace cap flowers atop of ruby stems.	4-5' tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Limetta	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Pretty lime green flowers emerge in early summer, and ages to a jade green. Blooms all summer.	3-4' tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Mini Mauvette	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Very large mophead flowers in a deep mauve-violet. Blooms on strong stems and blooms all summer.	2 1/2-3' tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Sublime	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Blooms in an uncommon shade of pale jade. A good cut flower.	4-5'	morning sun	prune hard to 12"
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Wee White	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Pure white, mop head flowers bloom all summer. Very cute.	1-2' tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Ruby	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Ruby red buds open to a two-toned combination of bright ruby red and silvery pink flowers. Strong stems, reblooms all season.	3-4'tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Arborescens Invincibelle Spirit	Smooth leaf hydrangea. Blooms start white, changing to pink then dark red by the end of the season. Blooms all season.	3-4' tall	morning sun	best to cut back at least 1/3 of the plant
H. Macrophylla Bloom Struck	Mop head type of hydrangea. The 3-5" blooms sit atop hardy red stems. The vigorous nature of this plant allows it to bloom on new and old wood. The ph. of the soil determines bloom color. Acidic soil results in blue blooms, less acidic soil results in purple blooms with a reddish hue.	3-4' tall	morning sun	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Macrophylla Endless Summer	Reblooming mophead type hydrangea known for it gorgeous flowers and ability to rebloom in mid-late summer. Blooms on both old and new wood. The ph. of the soil determines bloom color. Acidic soil results in blue blooms, alkaline soil will results in pink blooms.	3-4' tall	morning sun	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Macrophylla Summer Crush	A profusion of big raspberry red or neon purple blooms. A reblooming hydrangea.	18-36"	morning sun	prune out dead canes in spring

H. Macrophylla x H. Serrata Lets Dance Arriba	Large 7" flowers are quick to rebloom from early to late summer. Blooms on new and old wood. Color ranges from hot pink to purple-blue depending on your soil ph.	2-3' tall	morning sun	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Macrophylla x H. Serrata Let's Dance Can Do	Beautiful lace-cap blooms. One of the fastest reblooming hydrangeas. The default color is pink but can be turned lavender blue with aluminum and acidic soil.	3-4' tall	morning sun	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Macrophylla x H. Serrata Let's Dance Sky View	Reblooming hydrangea, shades of pink to sky blue depending on your soil type. One of the easiest to turn blue.	2-4' tall	part shade	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Macrophylla Pop Star	A prolific lace cap hydrangea with one of the fastest rebloom. Pink or blue depending on the soil ph.	18- 36" tall	part shade	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Macrophylla x Paniculata Wow Time	AKA. Princess Diana. Mopheads of starry, narrow-petaled double florets in glowing shades of salmon pink and deep pink. Blooms early summer through fall. Prune to shape for aesthetics only after flowering.	3-4' tall	part shade	blooms on old wood
H. Paniculata Berry White	Beautiful hydrangea that changes color from white to dark pink and finally deep red.	4-6' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Bobo	Perfect for small gardens. Bobo is compact and bushy boasting a profusion of large, rounded to conical flower heads. Opening pure white, the florets becoming flushed with pink as they age.	3'tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Candelabra	Candle shaped blooms start creamy white and transition into bright red with cooler nights.	4-6' tall	sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Firelight	Upright panicles are more round in shape and transform from pure white to pink then to a rich pomegranate.	5-6' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Firelight Tidbit	Perfect for small gardens. The blooms start white and slowly move through tones of pink until they reach a deep red. Big blooms cover the shrub all season.	2 - 3' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Diamond Rouge	Flower buds on this colorful hydrangea has 12-15" panicles of flowers that open up cream white but gradually darken to pink before becoming a rich red in fall with the cooler night temperatures.	4-5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Dragon Baby	Dwarf shrub with fantastic pink and green cone shaped panicles.	2-3' tall	Sun to part shade	blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Early Evolution	Early evolution blooms earlier than most paniculata in late May or early June. Flowers start lime-white changing to pure white to salmon pink and finally dark pink around September. Dome shaped flowers are produced in abundance. A very different paniculata.	24-28"	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Lava Lamp Candelabra	Enormous, candle-like flowers emerge crisp white in summer and mature to rosy red. Flowers are fragrant.	4-5'	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Limelight	Dramatic large blooms that range from lime green to creamy white to dusty rose. A heavy bloomer. Great as a cut flower.	6 - 8' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Limelight Prime	The same as Limelight hydrangea except it blooms a little earlier than limelight and is a little shorter.	4 -6' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Little Hottie	This little beauty is extremely compact with great branching. Flowers open a lime green then change to white.	3-5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Little Lime	Large flowers open lime green and then change to a rosy pink. Very floriferous.	4 -5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Little Lime Punch	Flowers emerge lime green and fade to an array of white, pink, and Hawaiian Punch red, often all showing at the same time.	3 - 5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood

H. Paniculata Little Quick Fire	One of the first hydrangea to bloom, flowers start off white, and turn to pink and red as summer goes by.	3 - 5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Moonrock	Large, lush clusters of flowers with petals that range from celestial white to soft green.	4-6' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Pinky Winky	Large white panicles opens in late summer and as summer turns to fall the florets at the base of the panicles turns pink. The results is a two-toned flower panicle that can reach up to 16" in length.	6 -8' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Phantom	Huge full flowerheads, measuring up to 15" long. Strong stems hold the flowers clusters upright.	6-10' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Puffer Fish	Puffer fish has fluffy white blooms that age to a warm pink. Very floriferous. A cute name.	3 -5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Quick Fire Fab	Large, upright, football-shaped blooms are densely packed. A very early bloomer. Coconut-lime color that quickly change to a wonderful watermelon hue.	6 - 8' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Strawberry Sundae	Flowers emerge creamy white changing to pink as night temperature drop. Much like Hydrangea Vanilla Strawberry but smaller.	4 to 5' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Tiny Quick Fire	One of the smallest panicle hydrangea yet, blooms early, starting white and changes quickly to reddish pink color.	1 1/2 - 3' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata Vanilla Strawberry	Giant flower heads begin pale green, quickly turning a rich shade of cream, later the flower head begin to blush pink, and by autumn the shrub has every shade from pistachio to rich rose.	6 -7' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Paniculata White Wedding	Crisp white blooms gives off a pillow like appearance. Blooms in abundance.	4-6' tall	Sun to part shade	Blooms on new wood
H. Petiolaris	Climbing hydrangea. Fragrant white flowers in flat-topped clusters (to 8" wide) bloom in late spring to early summer. Slow to establish but quite vigorous thereafter.	30' tall	Part shade to full shade	Prune immediately after flowering, cut back any dead or straggly stems and shorten any wayward stems.
H. Quercifolia Gatsby Pink	Oakleaf hydrangea. Gatsby Pink boast big, showy blooms that transform from pure white to a glorious pink. Fall foliage is a burgundy red.	6-8' tall	Sun to shade	Prune shortly after flowering if needed
H. Quercifolia Pee Wee	Oakleaf hydrangea. Pee Wee has showy flowers that appear in early to mid summer as the flowers age they fade to a pink. Fall foliage is a burgundy red.	3-4' tall	Sun to shade	Prune shortly after flowering if needed
H. Quercifolia Queen of Hearts	Regal ivory to mauve blossoms up to 9" long sit atop deep green oak-like foliage. Fall color is burgundy red.	5-6' tall	Sun to shade	Prune shortly after flowering if needed
H. Quercifolia Ruby Slipper	Oakleaf hydrangea. Ruby slipper has gorgeous, 9"flowers. White blooms turn pink then rose red. Fall foliage is a burgundy red.	4-5'	Full sun to shade	Prune shortly after flowering if needed
H. Quercifolia Snow Queen	Oakleaf hydrangea. Snow Queen has large, dense, white flower clusters that are held upright, midsummer blooms develop a rosy pink hue. Fall foliage is a burgundy red.	4-5' tall	Sun to shade	Prune shortly after flowering if needed

H. Quercifolia Toy Soldier	White and green flowers sit atop sturdy stems. Fall foliage is a rich vermillion red.	4-5' tall	Sun to shade	Prune shortly after flowering if needed
H. Serrata Tuff Stuff	Mountain hydrangea. Lace cap flowers on a very dependable shrub. Blooms are either pink or blue, depending on soil ph. Blooms on new and old wood.	2-3' tall	morning sun	prune out dead canes in spring
H. Serrata Tuff Stuff Top Fun	Lace cap blooms are supported by bright burgundy stems. Each flower is filled with cherry green florets at the center and purple or pink florets around the edges. Blue -purple in acidic soil-pink in basic soil.	2-3' tall	part shade	prune out dead canes in spring
